### Job Summary

Performs various duties as required to assist road crew personnel and others.

### Duties and Responsibilities

Installs and removes pavement markings and delineators.  
Participates in the assembly and erection of road signs.  
Performs rough carpentry, masonry, electrical, painting, and other building trade duties.  
Uses various hand tools such as electrical and pneumatic tools to cut posts, drill holes, fasten bolts, dig holes, etc.  
Operates tamps, swing blades, hand shovels, chain saws, drills, rollers, axes, rakes, and other similar equipment in maintaining and repairing roads.  
Repairs roadside ditches, works as a flagman for traffic control on road projects; drives small trucks.  
Sprays undesirable vegetation, cuts bushes, cleans out pipes, and patches potholes.  
Operates tractors performing road and right-of-way maintenance.  
Other duties as required.
